

Rotarians for Zhelevo Toronto's Historic Red Oak

Help save the home of a tree older than Canada!

Zhelevo is a majestic Red Oak located in a residential community near the Humber River in Toronto. It is well over 250 years old and was recognized as a Heritage Tree in 2009 thanks to the incredible efforts of Edith George, its neighbour and friend.

This Red Oak has witnessed history unfolding as a lookout tree overseeing the First Nations' Carrying-Place Trail. Every year, it captures more than 2.5 tonnes of carbon dioxide and currently stores over 31 tonnes of carbon above ground.

Now the lot on which Zhelevo grows is up for sale and funds must be raised quickly to secure the tree and its home for future generations.

The City of Toronto has agreed to purchase the property and establish the space as a parkette to preserve and showcase this beautiful example of our natural heritage. However, the purchase of sale is conditional upon the City fundraising \$430,000 <u>by December 12, 2020</u>. **To date there is a fundraising gap of approximately \$200,000**.
