### A full day of outstanding corporate entertainment.

- 7:00am** Listen to ZB cancellation service (refer to cancellation policy). Supplies available from Half Moon Bay Marina car park.
- From 7:30am** Assembly at your designated marina. You'll be assigned to your fully provisioned vessel. This will include bait, your lunchbox and plentiful refreshments.
- 8:30am** Depart from your marina on your assigned boat for the day's fishing and frivolities on the Hauraki Gulf.
- 10:30am** Hook the first one.
- 11:30am** Sink the second one.
- 12:30pm** Stop counting!
- 3:30pm** Fishing competition ends, boats return to Motuihe Island.
- 4:00pm** Boats are assembled off Motuihe and participants transferred onto the beach.
- 4:30pm** Participants assemble on the beach for weigh-in.
- 5:00pm** Weigh-in of fish on beach concludes. The party starts for all guests.
- 5:30pm** Prizegiving dinner is served, mix & mingle on the beach with evening drinks.
- 7:00pm** Boats depart Motuihe and return to your marina or alternative if arranged.

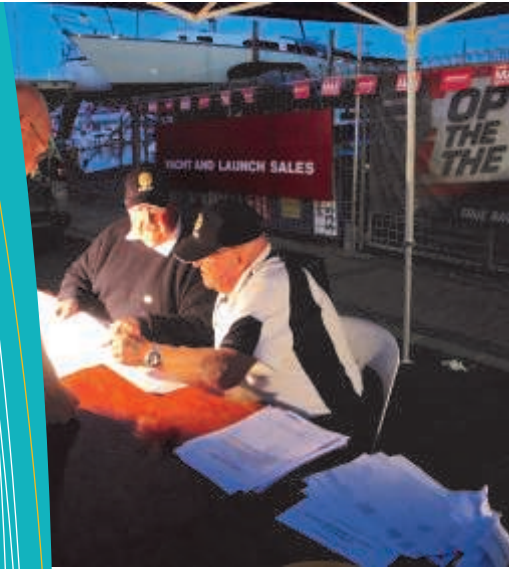
