BREAKING NEWS: District 6330 Conference Re-imagined to 2020 "E" Vision

We were advised this week, that in response to the CONVID-19 outbreak, UNIFOR our venue for the District Conference is now closed until September.

In view of this, and the current concerns pertaining to the CONVID-19 pandemic, and closures and cancellations that are required to maximize health related initiatives, we have decided that we will reformat and transform our conference into an online virtual event. This will negate the need for extensive travel and close contact by our members while still getting the benefit of the information that will be provided by our keynote speakers.

You may want to consider re-gifting any expenses you may have incurred at the in-person event to a CONVID-!9 response activity in your own community.

Our Team is working with our speakers, presenters and some volunteer techies on how we can deliver the BEST EVER Conference in this new world we are all coming to terms with. This is likely to be through a mix of live interaction, live streaming and the provision of off line information that clubs and club members can view at club meetings or from the comfort of their own home. The event will be a slimmed down version of what we had originally developed and will be held on the same weekend but on **Saturday June 20**th only.
