Our Honoree: Robert I. Ross

A longtime resident of Hampton Bays, Robert is currently VP of Community & Government Relations at Stony Brook Southampton Hospital. Prior to joining the hospital in 2008, he served for 6 years as Southampton Town Deputy Supervisor. During that time he was actively involved with the successful lobbying efforts to "Save" the 106th Rescue Wing in Westhampton Beach from the Federal BRAC Commisson.

Robert is a dedicated community volunteer. He is an honorary member of the Hampton Bays Volunteer Ambulance Corp., a member of the Audit Committee of the Hampton Bays Beautification Association, President of the Squire Woods Homeowners Association, a former member of the Dominican Sisters Charity in Action Board, a member of the Southampton Rotary, a former director of the Southampton Business Alliance and a former director of the Hampton Bays Civic Association.



He has served as the Chair & Commissioner of the Town's Public Safety Commission since 2009, and also serves as Treasurer of the Town's Medical Services Advisory Committee. In 2018 -- after a 15-year lobbying effort -- Robert was successful in seeing the NY State Legislature enact the required legislation to establish a 9-11-01 Commemorative License Plate.



About the Pine Neck Meadows Dog Park:

The Pine Neck Meadows Dog Park will be created on a 3-acre parcel owned by the Town of Southampton on Head of Lots Road in East Quogue. This will be the only designated dog park between Shirley and Southampton since the closure of the popular Bide A Wee public area in Westhampton. With a projected cost of \$75,000 (mostly for fencing), the Rotary Club of Hampton Bays has pledged \$3500 to create water fountains for pets and their owners. This is in keeping with Rotary's longstanding commitment to promoting healthy and safe drinking water locally and globally.
