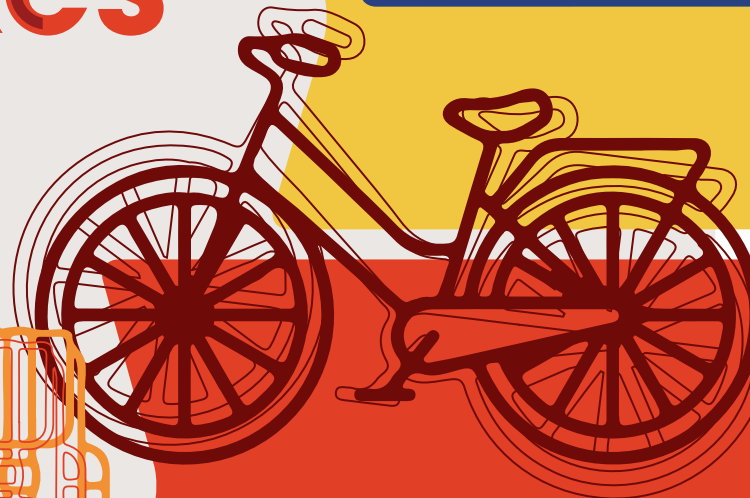
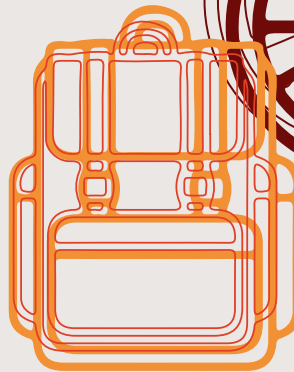

Backpack for Kids, launched in 2004, is the 'Signature Project' for Sunrise Rotary. We supply a new backpack filled with school supplies to public school children in grades K-5, high school students enrolled in the STEP (Students in Transition Empowerment Program) program, as well as to partner agencies. Since the program's inception, we have donated over 14,000 backpacks.

Born to Read spreads the word about the importance of reading, talking, and singing with children right from the start through outreach to families before birth, immediately after birth, and during the first three years of life. Last year, through these outreach strategies, we reached nearly 4,000 parents and distributed over 2,600 children's books in our community.

Education for Malawi

Members from our Club traveled to the Mangochi District of Malawi in 2016, 2017, and 2019 to help construct new school facilities. We continue to address the educational needs in Malawi through the 2021 "Secondary School Bicycle Share Project." This project will provide bikes for transportation to school, two micro-loan bicycle repair businesses for sustainability, and vocational repair training for interested students.
