## Tournament Schedule



In a Tournament all players start with an equal amount of chips; for this event the starting amount is $\$ 3,500$. As play progresses, the mandatory blind bets and the minimum bets increase and more players will lose all their chips and be eliminated.

Players will be seated at 5:45 pm. Play will begin with the first round at 6:00 pm.

## Finish and Prizes

The finishing position in the tournament is the order in which players lose all their chips and are eliminated; the last player left is the winner. The "Final Table" will be the last eight to ten players, depending on the total number of entries. All Final Table players will receive trophies and will be allowed to select their own prizes from those available, with the winner choosing first.

## Team Competition

Teams of 5 players in the main event will compete for the Team trophies. A team receives 30 points for a 1st place finish, 29 for 2 nd, down to 1 point for 30th place.

## Rebuy and "Second Chance"

Each player is allowed two "Rebuys" of additional chips, if they lose all their chips before the end of the third round ( 80 minutes of play). The Rebuy is $\$ 2,500$ in chips for an additional contribution of $\$ 20$.
There will also be "Second Chance" tables for players who are eliminated from the main event before the end of round 4. Entry donation for a Second Chance event is $\$ 20$. Each Second Chance table will be a separate tournament of 6-9 players with a prize for the winner. Second Chance Players will begin with a chip count of $\$ 3,000$. The blinds for the Second Chance will start at $\$ 50-\$ 100$ and double every 15 minutes.
