*The Rotary Community Walk & Bike Event consists of both a 6 mile walk and a 12 mile cycling event along the newly opened section of the Canalway Trail, from the Stevens Street Bridge in Lockport to Buffalo Niagara Heritage Village in Amherst. The purpose of the event is to promote greater awareness of the Niagara River Greenway as well as to promote fitness and wellness for Western New York residents. Participants may also qualify for enrollment in the cross-state **Canalway Challenge**.*

### REGISTRATION

Participants must register in advance online, at [www.clubrunner.lockportnyrotary.com](http://www.clubrunner.lockportnyrotary.com). Registrants will be required to sign a Waiver of Liability, holding harmless the Lockport Rotary Club, NYS Canal Corporation, Cornerstone Community Federal Credit Union, and Buffalo Niagara Heritage Village.

### COST

There is no cost for registration. Participants will have the opportunity at the event to donate to The Rotary Foundation's Polio Plus Campaign to eradicate childhood polio worldwide.

### PARKING & TRANSPORT

Parking is available for participants at Cornerstone Community Federal Credit Union and at Buffalo Niagara Heritage Village. Limited parking is available at the Canalway Trail trailhead locations at the Stevens Street Bridge, at the Robinson Road Bridge and at the Fisk Road Bridge. Participants are required to arrange for their own return transportation following the conclusion of their walk/bike trip.
