Second Servings is Houston's only prepared and perishable food rescue organization. The nonprofit is on a mission to direct perfectly edible surplus food from businesses and fill people's stomachs, not the city's landfills. Second Servings picks up unserved and unsold food from convention centers, sports venues, distributors, hotels, etc. and executes free same-day delivery to more than 80 local shelters, soup kitchens, low-income housing and many other charities. Since Second Servings of Houston began operations in 2015, the team has rescued approximately 3 million pounds of food, valued at more than \$20 million, from over 200 food donors. 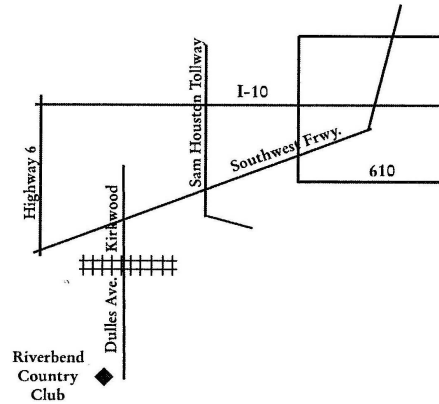

After retiring from a successful marketing career with Unilever and Mars, Barbara founded **Second Servings of Houston**, the city's only prepared and perishable food rescue organization. Since operations began in 2015, the nonprofit has rescued over 3 million pounds of food worth more than \$20 million. The organization serves 90 charity recipient sites that reach 170,000 needy Houstonians annually. She has received numerous awards and honors for her community service, including most recently, the Mayor's Proud Partner Award and the Houston Humanitarian Award. Barbara graduated from Tufts University, before earning an MBA in Marketing from NYU.
