Theme:

- 1. The Four-Way Test of all the things we think, say or do:
 - Is it the TRUTH?
 - Is it FAIR to all concerned?
 - Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
 - Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?
- 2. Contestants should choose a challenge within their community, school, state, nation, or family and apply the Four-Way Test.
- 3. Art entry must be an original work, created by the contestant.
- 4. Medium: Art entry must fall into one of the following categories of painting, drawing, photography, ceramic, sculpture or video (DVD Quicktime Video, 3 minutes or less).
- 5. Dimensions: Art entry may not exceed 50 inches in any one direction, i.e. 50"H, 50"W and 50"D.

Must Provide own easel for display

District Contest Cash Prizes:

1st Place \$1,000.00* 2nd Place \$ 500.00 3rd Place \$ 250.00

* The First Place Winner will be invited to display and explain his or her piece of art at the District Conference in Lake Arrowhead, CA May 1 -May 3, 2020.

Official Rules:

- Only <u>one</u> art contestant per Rotary Club is allowed.
- 2. Contestant must be currently enrolled in high school or home schooled and of high school age.
- 3. Contestant will compete at the sponsoring Rotary Club by **February 14, 2020**. Clubs may determine awards for winners at club level competition.
- Club winners will advance to the District finals to be held March 14,
 at Loyola Marymount University.
- 5. Registration form and **photo of the art piece** must sent **to** the sponsoring Rotary Club, no later than **February 10, 2020**.

- 6. Entry must be labeled with title, name of artist, medium and dimensions (HxWxD).
- 7. If there is only one contestant for the District Art Contest, he or she must display and explain the piece of art on **March 14, 2020**.
- Parent or legal guardian permission required. See Registration form.
