What to expect

10:00 Meet at the designated location. The meeting location may change due to water level and flow of the river that is deemed best for floating conditions.

10:10 Load the bus, drive to the launch site.

11:00 Plan for a short walk to the vessels on a dirt path.

Quick lesson for first time paddlers. Put in the river.

Float the Kaw River! Depending on weather, wind, flow of the river and your personal speed preference, allow four to six hours to float back to your vehicle at the initial meeting point. Depart on your own.

What's included

Kayak or canoe, shuttle service to drop location, flotation device, oars.

What to bring

Lunch or snacks, beverages of choice. Bottled water, sunscreen, trash bag. Alcohol is allowed, avoid glass containers. There is little room in the vessel. We suggest a six pack cooler for kayaks and 12 pack style cooler for canoes.

What to wear

There are no fashion rules on the river. Wear what is comfortable and what you are willing to get wet and muddy. River/water shoes, clothes that dry easily (nylon), hat. Check the weather and bring a jacket if cool. Dress in layers.
