Jennifer Jones (Vice President RI 2016-2017) - As one of Rotary International's most recognized communicators, Jennifer has addressed conventions and conferences across North America and abroad, including Russia, Panama, Thailand, Portugal, Finland, India, Sri Lanka, Spain, Australia, New Zealand, Fiji, England, Korea, Taiwan, Brazil, Greece, Italy and Germany. Given her extensive travels and experiences in humanitarian service, Jennifer developed a keen sense of Peacemaking and Peacekeeping. She will share her perspectives and lead the conversations on this most important Rotary Area of Focus.



Nicole Sinegar (Special Agent - Human Trafficking) - Nicole entered on duty with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) in 2008 and was assigned to the FBI's Criminal Investigation Division (CID). Throughout her career, SA Sinegar has gained invaluable analytical and investigative experience focusing on Organized Crime, Violent Gangs, Human trafficking, Hate Crimes, Color of Law, and Public Corruption federal violations. She will provide keen insight on how Human Trafficking is plaguing our communities and challenging the foundations of Peace.



Michael Franzese (Reformed Mob Boss) - In 1986, mafia boss, Michael Franzese was named by Vanity Fair as one of the biggest money earners the mob had seen since Al Capone. At the age of 35, Fortune Magazine listed him as number 18 on its list of the "Fifty Most Wealthy and Powerful Mafia Bosses". Avoiding traditional mob domains, Michael masterminded scams on the edge of the legitimate business world. From auto dealerships and union kickbacks, to Financial Services, to the Sports and Entertainment industries, to a multi- billion-dollar gasoline tax scheme, he earned millions in cash every week at his peak. Not surprisingly, Michael quickly became the target of Manhattan's famed federal prosecutor, Rudy Giuliani. He understands how a Peaceful society can be impacted by the criminal underworld and will share his perspectives.

William Hill (Kennan Institute Fellow) – An esteemed author of, "No Place for Russia", William was head of the Organization for the Security and Co-Operation in Europe (OSCE) Mission to Moldova. He was charged with negotiating a settlement to the Transdniestria conflict and facilitating withdrawal of Russian forces and arms from Moldova. He is a professor of national security strategy at the National War College and was a public policy scholar at the Woodrow Wilson Center in 2001– 2002. His intimate knowledge of the Peace negotiation process will prove enlightening.

Rev. Jerry Kramer (Director, Love for the Least) – Rev. Kramer has served the most afflicted groups of people across three continents. He is presently working in Northern Iraq to re-establish educational, vocational, and medical facilities, still under the threat of radical Islamic and authoritarian regimes. Through the Respect shown for human life and personal dignity, he has been able to uplift the poor and marginalized – particularly orphans, widows, and refugees/IDPs through inspired collaborations with civic, regional and religious leaders of all denominations. Rev. Kramer will share first-hand experiences of how loving one's neighbor can mollify long-standing divisions between people.

Mikael Ahlberg (Rotary Presidential Co-Advisor to Russia) – A Rotarian since 1993, Mikael is a member of the Rotary Club of Oland Sodra, Sweden. He has held numerous leadership positions from GSE Team Leader to District Governor, to RI Director for Zones 15-16, and most recently as RI Treasurer. Leveraging his depth in international relations, and his present efforts to grow Rotary's presence in Russia, Mikael will provide insight into how Rotary is increasing its administrative and humanitarian presence in a country trying to adopt peaceful and Service Above Self measures.
