How to find Rotary Centennial Grove in Hermann Park near the corner of Fannin Street & Cambridge Street!

Park in the Houston Zoo main parking lot. Standing in front of the main entrance gate of the Zoo, turn and walk along the walkway towards McGovern Lake (the parking lot will now be on your right). At the first walkway, make a left (now, the Zoo will be on your left, McGovern Lake on your right) and follow that walkway beside McGovern Lake towards the "Buddy Carruth Playground" and "Bob's Fishing Pier".
