Jeffrey Keahon Award

The nominee for the Jeffrey Keahon Award should be a Rotarian who has supported the Rotary Foundation through his/her actions. The nominee may have actively promoted the Foundation in his/her club, may have organized fund raisers for the Foundation or may have provided programs on the Foundation to your club. The nominee could also be someone who has promoted, supported or assisted the Foundation at the District level.

Tansukh Dorawala Award

The nominee for the Tansukh Dorawala Humanitarian Award should be a Rotarian who has provided exemplary service to humanity through his actions in Rotary and especially in using the resources of the Rotary Foundation, such as using Global Grants and/or District Grants. The nominee may be someone who has been successful in promoting the use of the District Grants and/or the Global Grants.
