# RYLA Rotarian Representative Checklist and Timeline

#### February-March 2017

- I. Confirm with your participating High Schools the date and location of this year's RYLA conference:
  - Sunday, June 25 Wednesday June 28, 2017 at New Jersey City University, Jersey City, NJ
- II. Guaranteeing Your Candidate's place at the Conference
  - Fill out the "RYLA Conference Reservation Form" after confirming with your club the number of students it will sponsor
  - Have your club treasurer write the check for the conference (\$475 per student). Sorry, no partial payments accepted
  - Send Check and Reservation form to:

- III. Recruit Your High School Junior Applicants Early
  - · Refer to enclosed "RYLA Guidelines for Selecting Attendees"
  - · Once selected, confirm selection with student's school administration

IV. Follow up to ensure that accepted RYLA candidate students and legal guardians fill out the online information, registration and consent forms. A RYLA candidate will not be a confirmed attendee unless this documentation is completed.

Candidate acceptance letters with RYLA details <u>can not</u> be sent until all information is received from students. Late submission of documents will delay getting important information to the candidate & his/her family & puts additional pressure on the Club RYLA Rep.

#### \*\*\*\* Special Note:

- 1. There is no transportation provided to NJCU. Candidate's parents or Rotarians are responsible for drop off and pick up.
- 2. Closing ceremonies to be held 6PM, June 28th at NJCU.

In the event a candidate needs to be sent home, the RYLA Representative will be contacted to arrange immediate pickup. If a parent cannot get their child, the sponsoring Rotary Club should send a vetted member authorized to bring the student home.

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### ROTARY YOUTH PROTECTION POLICY

It is your responsibility to familiarize yourself with the District's Rotary Youth Protection Policy. The policy is available on the District's website, <a href="https://www.rotarydistrict7490.org">www.rotarydistrict7490.org</a>, by clicking on "Youth Protection" under Programs. Rotarians or other non-Rotarian volunteers transporting RYLA students or otherwise having unsupervised one-on-one contact with participating youth are required to receive a criminal background check and be vetted. In addition, such persons, as well as, those directly involved in the RYLA program, including selection, should be trained. A slideshow and quiz are also available on the website. Questions may be

#### RYLA Candidate Selection Guidelines

- 1. The students your Club selects to be its representatives MUST be high school students who will enter their senior year in September. He/she cannot be 18 years of age before the end of the conference.
- 2. The high school should present your Rotary Club with two or three times the number of qualified candidates you plan to select. Your Committee should then interview and choose the most qualified students to represent that school and your Club.
- 3. The following considerations are offered as possible criteria to be used in your selection process. Consider the student that is not chosen for every other thing at school but the one who deserves it!:
  - Leadership Potential Those qualities that might make him/her an effective leader in the community
  - Leadership Experience Has the student had opportunities to practice leadership skills in real life situations? (Look for officers of school organizations, athletic team partcipants, and extracurricular leadership experience)
  - Extracurricular Activities Emphasize quality of involvement rather than quantity. Has he/she participated in any community activities? Does he/she have a job after school, evenings, or weekends?
  - Ability to Question Does the student think about things that he/she reads or hears, or does he/she accept things blindly?
  - · Articulation Is the candidate capable of expressing thoughts and feelings accurately, clearly, and effectively.
  - Ability to Relate and Interact with Peers How well does the candidate get along with others and adapt to social situations?
  - Openness to the Conference Experience Will the candidate be open and adaptive to embrace the philosophy of the RYLA Conference
- 4. We recommend selecting multiple alternate candidates who will be prepared to attend the Conference in the event that any of your primary candidates could not attend. Last minute cancellations and the problems that they cause could be eliminated with the selection of pre-qualified alternates.
- 5. We are looking for interested, sincere, well-rounded potential leaders.

The selection of good Conference participants by Rotarians is the critical element in the success of the RYLA Program.
