



Terms and Conditions of Entry to Star Search 2017

- Entry to **Highton Rotary Star Search** is open to performers who:
 - a. Are amateur vocalists, instrumentalists and groups who do not earn their primary income from the field of entertainment or teaching music.
 - b. Live or study in the Greater Geelong region
- **Performing Times**

Auditions: The adjudicators may not require you to complete your full performance if they are able to make a decision on what they have heard.

Heats: (when required) Items should be no longer than five minutes

Grand Final: The preferred time is five minutes or less. It is requested that the same piece performed in the audition is then performed at the Grand Final

Past Competitors

Past winners are ineligible to compete again in the same section. Individual members of past winning groups may compete and as soloists. In all other cases please discuss in advance with the organisers.
- Finalists must arrange for their own accompaniments. A piano will be provided at McAuley Hall. Any other backing instrument will be the contestants responsibility. Pre-recorded backing will NOT be permitted at the Grand Final.
- It will be at the discretion of the organisers to combine two or more sections of the competition should that be considered necessary.

- The entry fee will be \$5 per Act. This is payable on the Audition Night.
