After weeks of searching she found her first five lady veterans and established Clearview H.O.P.E. (Helping Our Patriots Everywhere).

H.O.P.E is a cost-free, year-round, recreational and therapeutic golf program specifically for women military veterans. Ladies from every branch of service are welcome to join. The program begins each year with six weeks of lessons followed by regular play and continuous instruction each Friday of the golf season.

Since its inception, H.O.P.E has grown to more than 50 members serving women all throughout Northeast Ohio. Over the years, H.O.P.E has become more than just a golf program. It is simply a family, a family of ladies who share a sister-like bond supporting each other on and off the fairways.




