Presidents-elect Training Seminar (PETS) will be held February 24 to 26, 2017 in Denver, Colorado at the Renaissance Hotel. The registration deadline is February 3, 2017. Followed by dinner we will hold our first breakout session which is an introduction breakout so it will be short, followed by a hospitality social. However, if you sign up for Rotary 101 on Friday, February 24th, it begins at 1:30 PM. Register at www.highcountrypets.org by selecting the appropriate D5440 menu option under the dropdown menu of the Registration Links for 2017 PETS on the top toolbar.

Room reservations at the Renaissance must be made by February 3rd to be included in the Rotary room block. A convenient link is available on the PETS web site. I strongly encourage you to stay at the hotel during PETS. It will improve your ability to be involved in the PETS experience. Also, please be aware that our district or your club could incur extra expense if the PETS room block is not utilized.
