## -RIPPR Stephanie Urchick-

A Rotarian since 1991, Dr. Stephanie A Urchick is a member of the Rotary Club of Canonsburg Houston Southpointe, and is a Rotary Foundation (TRF) Major Donor and Bequest Society member. She has served Rotary as a Foundation Trustee, RI and TRF Committee member, District Governor, Regional Foundation Coordinator for ZONE 29, International Training Leader, RI President's Representative, Regional Leaders Training Institute Moderator, district delegate to Councils on Legislation, Training Leader at Zone meetings, and in various club and district Foundation roles. During Rotary year 2016-17, Stephanie will chair The Rotary Foundation Centennial Celebration Committee and the Strategic Planning Committee. Stephanie is a certified instructor for the Rotary Leadership Institute, and has trained major donor possibility teams in six Zone 29 districts.

In 2013, Stephanie organized a "million dollar dinner" for three Rotary districts that generated \$3 million for TRF. Stephanie is the CEO/Executive Director of the Southpointe CEO Association

located in southwest Pennsylvania, and a partner and Chief Operating Officer of Doctors At Work LLC, a consulting and training company aimed at assisting businesses and individuals with leadership development, communication, and customer service. Stephanie became the first ATHENA Award recipient for Washington County, PA, has been honored by Zonta International and the Sons of the American Revolution, was named District 7330 Rotarian of the Year, and has received TRF's Distinguished Service Award.

She has participated in a variety of international service projects, including National Immunization Days in India and Nigeria, the building of an elementary school in Vietnam, filter installation in the Dominican Republic, and mentoring new Rotarians in the Ukraine. With the Rotary Club of Krakow, Poland, Stephanie coordinated a district-wide TRF matching grant to secure mammography equipment and a biopsy unit for a hospital in Poland. In its commemorative book, the Rotary Club of Krakow noted Stephanie Urchick as one of the agents helping the re-birth of Rotary in post-Communist Poland.
