Other Information on Lakeside Amusement Park that Might be Handy

- 1. The Park opens at 12:00 noon, with the Kiddie rides open at noon. But the major rides open a little later at 1:00 pm. The Kiddie rides close at 10:00 pm and the major rides close at 11:00 pm (or a little later sometimes depending on weather/crowd et.al.)
- 2. The Rain Date is set at the discretion of the Lakeside Amusement Park.
- 3. There is no requirement to buy a ride pass to enter the Park. You can buy an admission ticket for \$3.50 and then buy individual ride tickets if you want. Parents or grandparents who may not want to ride the 'big' rides can just pay \$3.50 for the entrance pass for themselves and bring the children with full pass tickets for them. The parents or grandparents can ride the 'Kiddie' rides with the smaller kids for a few dollars more.
- 4. People bringing picnics to the Park are fine. However, they cannot barbeque (no hibachis or grills); no glass bottle or containers, and no alcoholic beverages. There are plenty of picnic tables and the central park area is lined with benches. The Park is fine with people bringing in their own food. If a club wanted to have catered food, they can contact Lakeside who uses Stellar Catering to provide pretty much Stellar Catering's entire menu.
- 5. General information: Food is very reasonably priced. No guarantees but hot dogs are \$1.75, jumbo dogs are \$3.00; big corn dogs are \$2.00; a slice of pizza is \$2.00; ice cream cones for \$2.00 and a waffle cone may be \$3.00; Hamburgers are around \$4.00 with a double cheeseburger around \$6.25. Super nachos might be around \$6.50 but are huge. There is cotton candy, funnel cakes, and a wide variety of candy very reasonably priced. The concessions and games are varied and reasonable as well with good prizes.
- 6. The Picnic ticket includes admission and parking. If you do not use a picnic ticket, the only charge is \$3.50 for admission. There is no parking charge.
