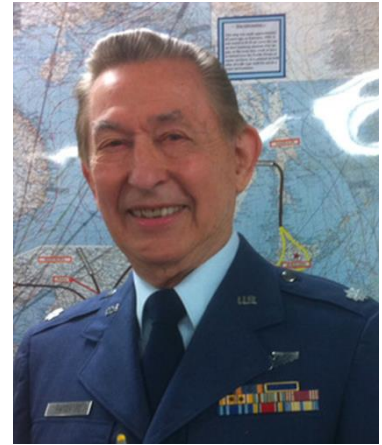


Hartford Rotary Presents:

of its day.

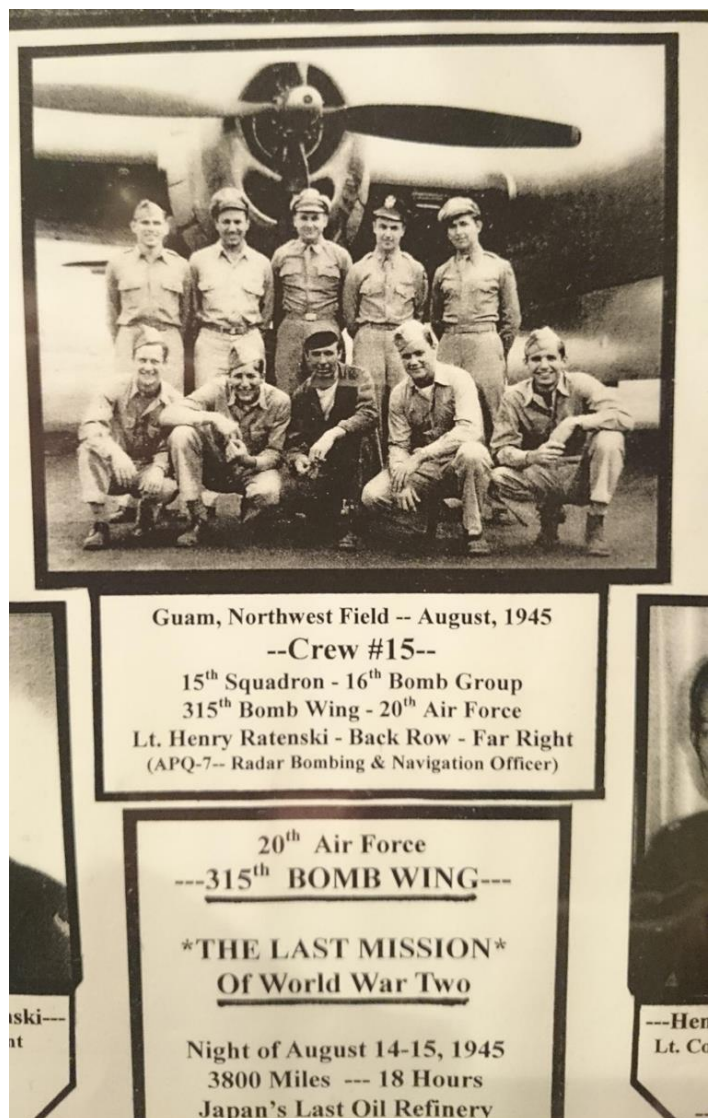
He will tell the dramatic story of
