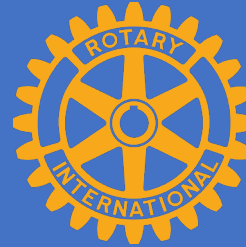

The WPRC & Foundation have a rich history of engaging in the support of community projects throughout the world.

Locally, numerous community efforts are supported annually. The Rotary Circle/ Pathway at Boerner Botanical Gardens is its prize project. The ADA-accessible path and circle have made an area of the gardens available for the enjoyment of all visitors.



Globally, the WPRC & its Foundation yearly support water purification projects and the elimination of Polio. They coordinated a Global Grant with The Rotary Foundation (and provided \$6,000) that benefitted the Happy Home, an educational institution for disabled children in the Kolar Gold Fields, Karnataka, India. The Global Grant included a solar-powered electrical system, a water purification system, and training for the Happy Home staff by Easter Seals Southeast Wisconsin.
