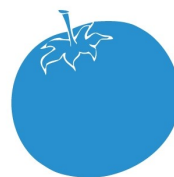

The extra time is used with the new water source to start a vegetable garden and feed a family.



Kids spend more time in school instead of walking for water. They graduate to become teachers, nurses or business owners.



A nearby community learns how water changed the village. They petition for a water project too, and the cycle starts again.
