The presidents-elect training seminar (PETS) is designed to prepare incoming club presidents for their role and give District Governors-elect, District Coordinators and incoming Area Governors the opportunity to motivate incoming Presidents and build working relationships. It also provides a great springboard for club Presidents to form cluster relationships which have proven to be exciting avenues for service.

All Presidents-elect are required to attend PETS unless the governor-elect excuses them. Presidentselect who are excused need to send a club representative in their place.

Check-in will open from 9am on Saturday morning with proceedings commencing at 10 am sharp. This will hopefully allow time for travel and mean that accommodation in most cases will only be required for Saturday night. We intend to finish at noon on Sunday.
