COMMUNITY FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITY

We can offer continuing assistance in the supply of book stocks as well as a complete operations summary to assist in establishing and continuing on, in another community, such a project.

In short, there is a whole of Club commitment for 3 days of sale set up and sale time, including packing up of unsold stock and clearing the sale venue, together with a continuing availability of folk to receive book donations, sort and categorise stock and make ready stock for the next Book Sale.

This is a very abbreviated summary of this opportunity to work with your community on your own or in conjunction with another neighbouring Club, to provide your Club(s) with an ongoing source of funding.
