- Determining the need for sanitary products and ensuring menstrual equity by conducting a prospective survey over a 3month period. This survey/study would involve females using a specified age range from various districts throughout Trinidad and Tobago.
- <u>Submission</u> of study results to the relevant authorities and stakeholders involved. The subsequent formation of a parliamentary subcommittee to assimilate the relevant information, determine feasibility including





'Crown Her ' - Steps Involved (Continued)

 <u>Debating</u> in parliament and subsequent enactment of the relevant legislation into the laws of Trinidad and Tobago.

• <u>Proclamation</u> of the established law and dissemination of at least one free appropriate menstrual product to all females especially to those in the lower economic strata.
