Interactors' Safety

- Only friends and family of Rotary are allowed in the group
 - Prospective members are asked 3 questions to determine if they have a Rotary background
 - Members are invited by Group's Admin
- Group is monitored by Rotarians

Content Guidelines

- Ensure permission is granted from school and parents
- If consent is not received, pictures of the project should be posted, not the students
- With help of teachers ensure the posts/pictures are appropriate e.g. clothing, pose, language, relevance
- Visit Rotary's Brand Center create logos, rotary branding, presentations, colours, example of pictures that should be used
