WHAT: Here's how it works:

1. Form a team of 1 to 4 people:

Team of 1, 2, 3 or 4: \$100/person

Corporate Sponsor Team: \$500/team of up to 4

Professional Team: \$750/team of up to 4

Why choose a professional team?:

- If you fancy yourself a wine enthusiast, consider joining the professional team. You don't have to be a "professional"!
- Professional teams will blind taste and be scored in a category of their own, meaning the professional contestants will bring—and taste—better wines.
- If you are in the restaurant or alcoholic beverage industry, it's a great way to promote your business and win bragging rights.
- 2. Each team brings 3 bottles of the exact same wine (please bring white wine submissions pre-chilled). You can choose any wine so long as each bottle is the same. There is no minimum or maximum you need to spend.



- 3. Turn in the three bottles of wine at the event. Two are uncorked for blind tasting and scoring by the crowd. The third bottle is placed in reserve.
- 4. In both the ordinary and professional categories, the team that brought the highest scoring wine wins a random selections of 50% of the unopened bottles of wine. Second and Third place teams each take 25% of the remaining bottles.
- 5. In the meantime, we will hold a silent auction and hors d'oeuvres and non-alcoholic beverages will be served.
