# The RI Learning Centre

#### **Cover SLIDE: Introduction**

As Leaders and Officers of your Club it has in the past been usual for RI to provide you with a set of Manuals and Guides as references for the various Club Roles. But in an effort to phase out printed materials these are now only provided in electronic format. To complement these Manuals RI prepared a number of Training Courses which are available on the new upgraded Learning Centre.

The Learning Centre however, does not only have courses for Club Officers, there are also Training Plans for Committee Chairs and Members covering all aspects of Rotary, including a course on our recent Partnership with Toastmasters.

And all you need to access all this information, is being registered on "My Rotary" the RI Membership Portal.

The Learning Centre will keep informed and allow you and your Members to grow in Rotary.

#### SLIDE 2

To access the Learning Centre go to "My Rotary" on the Rotary website (<a href="www.rotary.org">www.rotary.org</a>) and hover the cursor [the little hand] over <a href="Learning & Reference">Learning & Reference</a> to produce the dropdown Menu and slide the cursor over to and click on the <a href="Learning Center">Learning Center</a>

#### SLIDE 3

Once you have accessed the **Learning Center** you will find the Course Catalogue which you can explore to find the Course that interests you. There are also various filter which will allow you to select the leadership category (and language selection if English is not for you).

#### SLIDE 4

Once you have selected a Course you will be taken to the course page where you will find information on the Learning Plan.

To start the Course click on ENROLL

Follow the course sequence and as you progress through the course you will be provided with various resources including videos and downloadable reference guides and manuals.

Once you have completed a Course remember to download your certificate.

This is your "Go To" page for all sorts of Reference Guides and Manuals.

#### SLIDE 9

Once on the page you will be able to access information by selecting the Role or Topic for which you require assistance.

#### SLIDE 10

As President Elect you would select the "President" Role where you will find out what to do during your year, how to prepare and the resources you will need.

Other Members would of course select the Role or Topic which would suit them best.
