Thanks also to **Rtn Sue Paget**, Programme Director for RFHD and Southern Africa and Global Programme Advisor for RFHA, for her informative and well delivered talks and presentations. She gave us an overview and the history of RFHA and explained her working on our behalf with the Ministry of Health, NGO's and the media.

In the absence of Co-chairman **Ubi Adams-Jack**, who extended her apologies, Sue gave an explanation and overview of the **Impact Study results from the 2016** which was most enlightening and informative. Ubi will be coordinating another survey again after this year's RFHD. She will explain the process at the next training session.

Gratefully, I had **PDG June Webber** on hand to welcome everyone - she has kindly offered her unfailing support as I negotiate my learning path through the RFHD organisation, and also **Rob Kydd**, who ensured the smooth running of the morning by making flawless changes from one presentation to the next.

I am grateful for the support of my own Club, **RC Cape of Good Hope** for the delicious eats and lovely hot beverages they provided and, of course, to YOU all for your attendance. There were over 30 people present and your enthusiasm and commitment made the day very special for me, and I thank you.

We are going to **be the Hundreds that Make a Difference to Thousands** in our communities on 3 to 5 October on the **ROTARY FAMILY HEALTH DAYS**, and I am so looking forward to working with you all in achieving just that!!

Feedback points from the discussions:

SITES:

- **Details of the Sites:** I MUST have all the details of your sites by TUESDAY 15 AUGUST. Email as soon as you have the details please.
 - This includes: NAME ADDRESS Nearest Clinic
- **Schools:** We have the "go ahead" from the National Dept of Health that Schools MAY be used as sites. The fact that the dates fall within the school holidays (as requested by everyone from last year) makes it even easier to get available sites, organise volunteers from the Interact Clubs, schools and the community plus, as a bonus, it makes for easier for the "She Conquers" programme, which aims specifically at the Youth. If we market this service, we can encourage more of the school learners and others to attend on the days
- **Tents:** A commitment was made by the National Dept of Health to supply each site with a tent to accommodate the She Conguers programme
 - As more info becomes available on that, I will let you know. For the moment keep it as a bonus that may come your way.
- **Event permit –** This should be looked into where appropriate as the Western Cape Government is strictest on Health and Safety.
- Dates of the RFHD 2017
 - Concern was expressed about the SASSA payment day overlapping and thus creating problems with venues for some Clubs.
 - We now have the agreement that the RFHD will run between Tuesday and Friday 3-6 October so that you can be flexible in your dates.
 - It is hoped that this will allow everyone to hold their day within the parameters of the National media's advertised dates.
- Hours of operation each day Rotary Clubs may negotiate and decide their own advertised hours with the Service providers and Clinic staff within the parameters of 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Provision of Refreshments / Food for the Service Providers and Volunteers after some robust discussions, it was finally agreed that each Club negotiate with their Service Providers and do their 'own thing' within their budget and the general parameters of a 'light snack' that will be offered to all 'workers' but not the general public.

WORKING WITH THE GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENT & CLINICS:

- We will rely on each Club Champion & Committees to make contact with your nearest Municipal or Provincial Clinics and Health professionals.
- A meeting is set for Monday 31 July to set up the co-operation with the respective Heads of Departments. You will all receive a separate mail from me in this regard as soon as it becomes available

MEDIA & COMMUNICATIONS / PUBLIC IMAGE:

- Media Representative: Rob Kydd has agreed to act as our Media Representative. If you have any queries, contact him directly
 - Any request for interviews on radio of TV should be referred to Robert or Bev for help and support
- <u>Branding:</u> Please us the RFHD branding logos on all your correspondence see the attached Logos document For example: Use the signature (see the example at the bottom of this page) in your emails or as letter heads in a letter
 - This is a wonderful opportunity for us to market Rotary in the community and beyond let's make the best of it
- Posters/ Fliers T-shirts: Final artwork will be signed off this week.

We have created a platform for accessibility on our website www.rfhdsouthafrica.org and materials will be available to downloading from there.

The posters are in the final stages of approval by the NDOH, the radio ads are uploaded already, and the press releases to date are available. T-shirt design and other information will follow shortly. We will be contacting you for your orders on the Number of Poster & Fliers plus the languages you would require for each site, so please start thinking about that in the meantime
