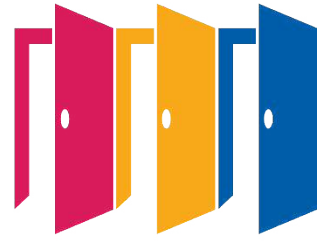

The Rotary Foundation is the official charity of Rotary, created in 1917 by Rotary International's sixth president, Arch C. Klumph, as an endowment fund for Rotary "to do good in the world." It has grown from an initial contribution of US\$26.50 (made by Rotary Club of Kansas City) to more than US\$1 billion. It has one of the largest and most prestigious international fellowship programs in the world.



- 1930 The Foundation awards its first grant: \$500 to the International Society for Crippled Children (Easter Seals).
- 1947 Paul Harris passes away...and Rotary members contribute \$1.3 million in his memory
- 1957 Paul Harris Fellow recognition begins (a Fellowship is awarded to recognize US\$1,000 in cumulative Foundation donations)
- 1965 Matched Grants program is launched, establishing a regular program for the Foundation to fund club and district projects
- 1978 Health, Hunger and Humanity (3-H) grants expand service efforts
- 1979 Rotary begins immunizing 6 million children in the Philippines against polio
- 1980 Rotary commits to "eliminate polio through immunization"
- 1985 The PolioPlus program is launched
- 1999 Rotary Peace Centers are founded
- 2004 The *Every Rotarian, Every Year* initiative is created
- 2007 The Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation issues its \$100 million challenge
