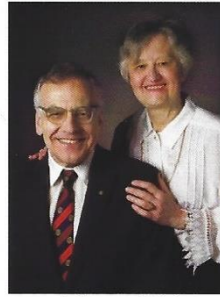
This year marks 50 years of service and commitment to the community for the Quesnel Tillicum Society Native Friendship Centre, and QTSNFC is throwing a two day celebration!

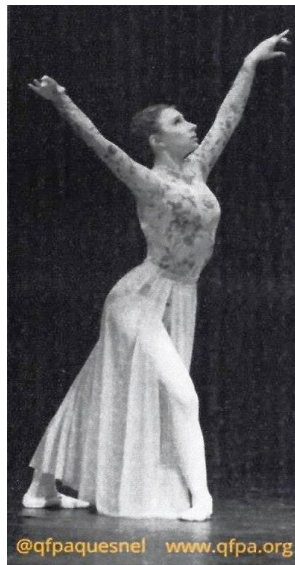

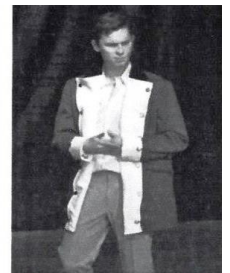
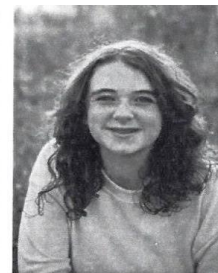
