What is The Rotary Club of Menlo Park?

Service Above Self is the focus of the Rotary Club of Menlo Park (RCMP.) Through our Club Foundation we serve surrounding communities, and provide financial support to local non-profits and programs. One annual grant goes to "The Almanac Holiday Fund" benefiting many local charities. Also, we serve the world through the Rotary International Foundation.

Activities sponsored by the RCMP include:

- The Annual Scholastic Achievement Awards/Scholarship program.
- Annual Tour de Menlo Scholarship bike ride that generates funding for our college scholarship program and community gifts program.
- Rotary Connects events brings together business, community and civic leaders. These partnerships allow us to combine resources, better serve those in need, and contribute to making our community a better place to work, live, and play.
- The Rotary Club/Belle Haven Community Garden located at Ivy and Market St. Thirty-five, free garden beds are provided to community families to encourage healthier food sources, and promote friendly neighborhood connections.

This past year challenged our club and the community due to the COVID-19 impacts. Despite restrictions on group gatherings, we made strong efforts to maintain community service via:

- Virtual meetings to conduct a DIY Tour de Menlo Scholarship bike ride.
- Emergency funding in the amount of \$40,000 provided to non-profits supplying families with food and necessities. \$50,000 is earmarked for additional funding to support families and individuals that continue to be impacted by COVID-19.
- Keeping open the Belle Haven community garden, and providing a Rotary Connects forum for the distribution of grants to local non-profits.
- Tonight's virtual Scholastic Awards/Scholarship event to recognize excellence in our local high schools and provide college scholarships to deserving seniors.

Our Foundation is a tax exempt 501(c)3 Charitable foundation which this year will give out \$208,000 in scholarships (for four year and community colleges). It receives donations and bequests from club members and outside individuals/organizations. Further, our club Foundation gives funding to local non-profits and Global projects.
