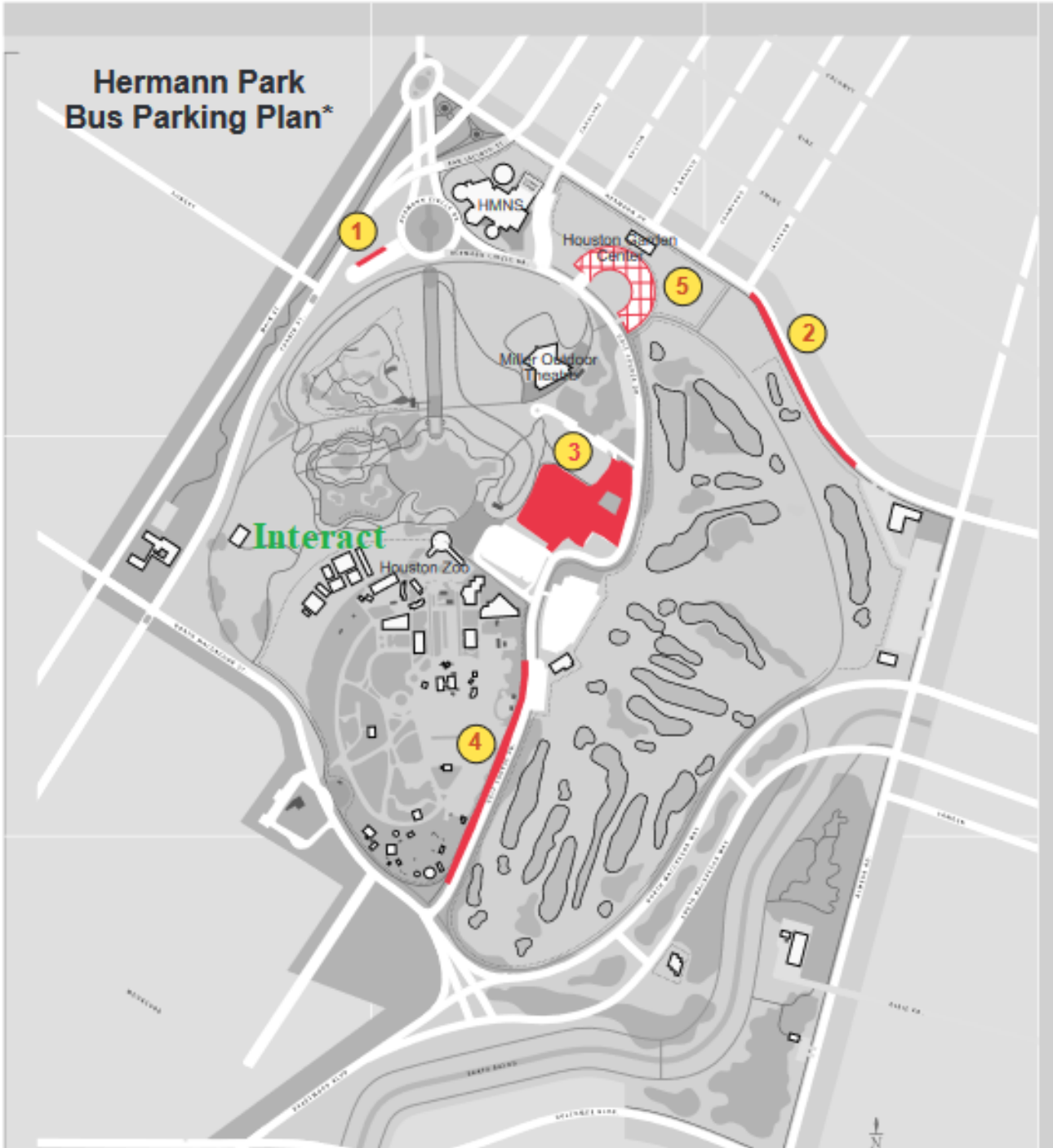

1. **ALL YOUTH AND ADULT PARTICIPANTS** must bring a completed Volunteer Waiver and Photo Release Form with them day of the event (Visit website mentioned above for the form)
2. **Parking: Cars** can park in Houston Zoo Parking Lots G, F, H or E.  
**Buses: Please see page #2, or call Hermann Park in advance for details: (832) 395-7100**
3. **How to find Rotary Centennial Grove in Hermann Park (near the corner of Fannin Street & Cambridge Street).** On the Map, look for "*Buddy Carruth Playground for All Children*"
  - Park in the **Houston Zoo main parking lots listed above.**
  - Standing in front of the main entrance gate of the Zoo, turn and walk along the walkway towards McGovern Lake (Zoo is now behind you & the parking lot is now on your right).
  - At the first walkway, make a left (now, the Zoo will be on your left, McGovern Lake on your right) and follow that walkway alongside *McGovern Lake* towards the "*Buddy Carruth Playground For All Children*" and "*Bob's Fishing Pier*".
  - Look for the Rotary & Interact signs in the *Lowe Pavilion* on your left.

4. The Interactors will meet at the Lowe Pavilion where all participants must sign in upon arrival and submit their consent forms to Tommie & Charlie Buscemi.
5. **Gardening Projects:** Volunteers will help with invasive weed removal and other gardening.
6. **Hermann Park Conservancy Volunteer Dress Code:** All volunteers must wear closed-toe shoes and long pants; weather appropriate clothing that **can get dirty**, wet, or muddy.  
**Do not wear:** shorts, halter tops, or clothing with references to alcohol, drugs, or sex, no sandals or flip-flops. Volunteers should wear comfortable clothing.
7. **Bring:** individual water bottles (with your name on it); a completed Hermann Park Conservancy waiver/photo release (this includes **ALL** leaders, chaperones, teachers, adults and youth).
8. **Severe Weather/Rain-date:** If there is severe weather, please keep in mind your safety comes first. Severe weather could be thunderstorms, lightning, or flooding. Hermann Park will notify Tommie Buscemi with Interact District 5890 if we need to cancel.
9. **If event is cancelled:** One person from each club needs to be the Communication Chair. If the event is cancelled, Tommie Buscemi will contact that person, and then that person will notify each volunteer in their group. Visit the "[Interact District 5890](#)" Facebook page for details.

Bus Parking Areas (as directed): \*\*

- 1 Sam Houston Parking Lot -12 spaces designated "Bus Parking Only"  
Parking in regular spaces not allowed \*\*\*
- 2 Bus Parallel Parking along Hermann Drive where designated
- 3 Bus Parking in central portion of Main Lot as directed\*
- 4 Bus Parallel Parking along Golf Course Drive where designated
- 5 Parking at Houston Garden Center - use as directed by Park personnel only

\* Parking areas subject to change as needed

\*\* Follow directions of Park Rangers and Houston Police to park in designated areas

\*\*\* Parking in non-designated areas without directions from staff may result in parking citations issued to violators
